The Federal Annual Inspection (FAI or FHWA) must be performed before the same date of the subsequent year. 7. On refrigeration units: (A) Check thermostat temperature at least every 8 hours during refrigeration unit use (B) Maintain sufficient fuel in supply tank for continued operation, (C) Check engine oil level and maintain at full mark.
